

**MINUTES  
OF THE GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING**

Bobbie reminded everyone of the Spring Meet being held in Lorena the next two Saturdays (April 12 & 19). Bobbie will be responsible for a sales table in an effort to reduce current inventory.

After the minutes of February 7, 2005 were reviewed by all, Bobbie made the motion and Jennifer seconded it that the minutes be approved as presented. The motion passed.
